- **Transitional Housing**

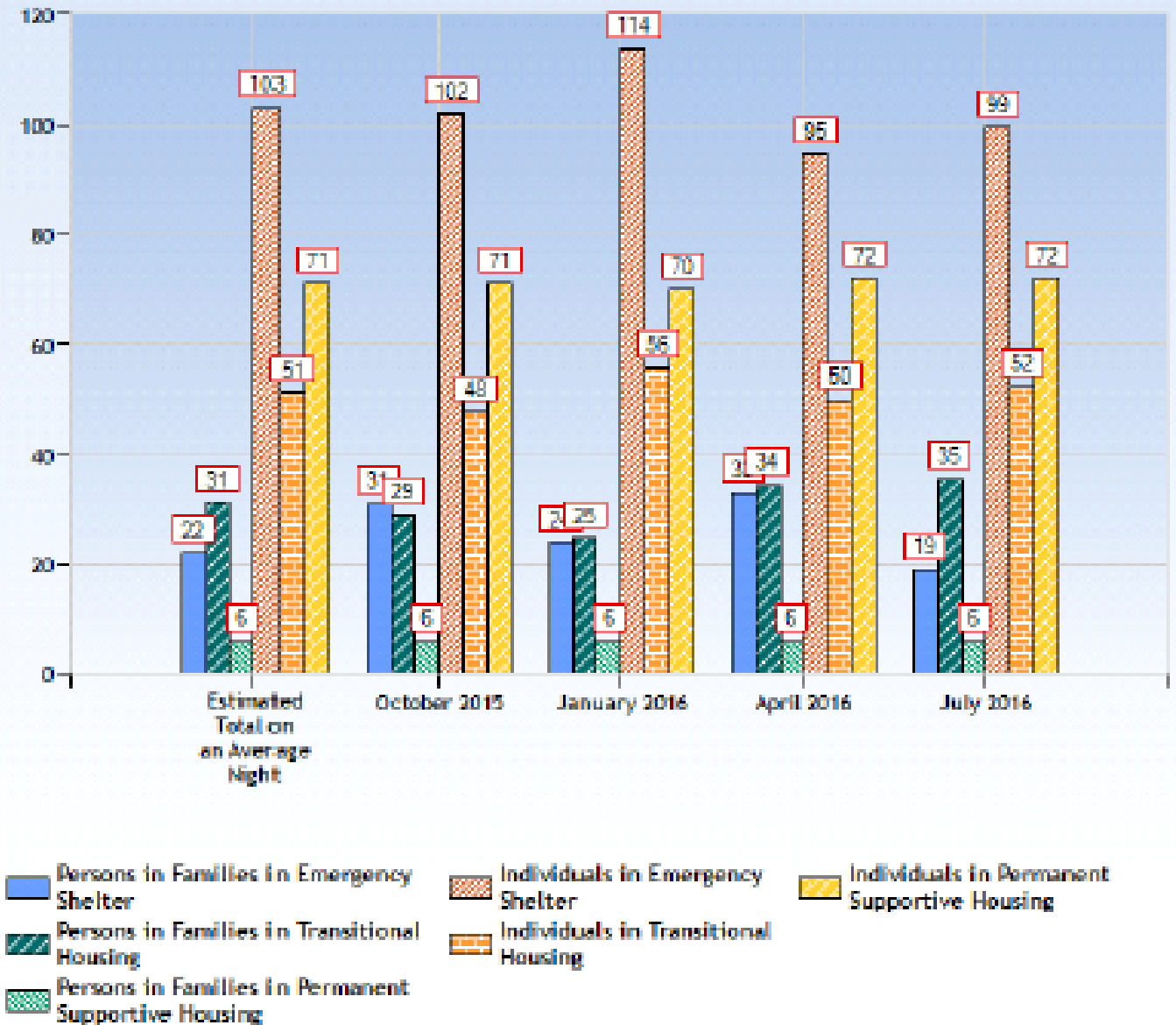
- Total Family Members: 45

- **Permanent Supported Housing**

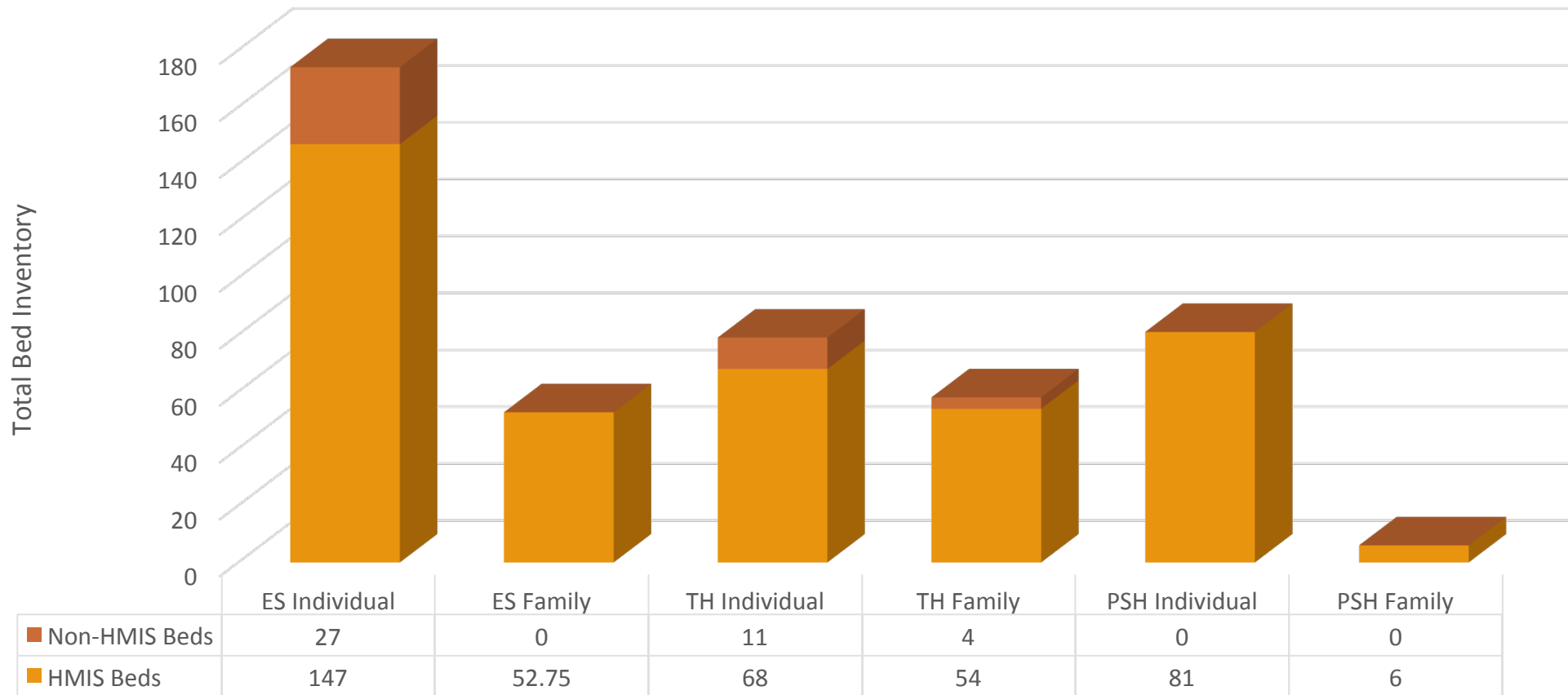
- Total Family Members: 6

Exhibit 1.3 Estimated Homeless Counts: Point in Time Counts

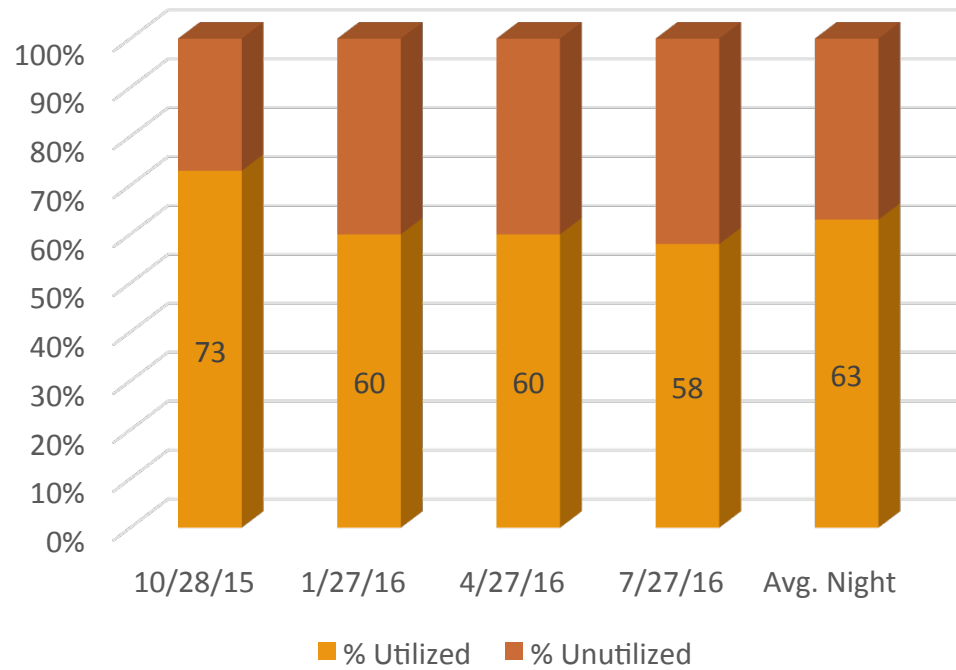

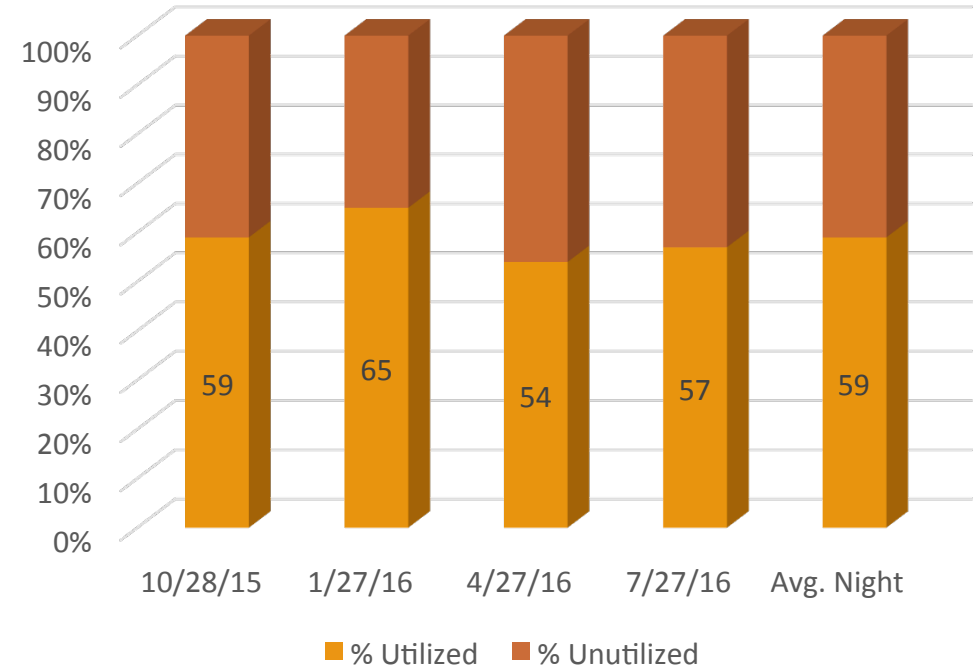


Emergency Shelter Occupancy Rates

ES Family Unit Utilization

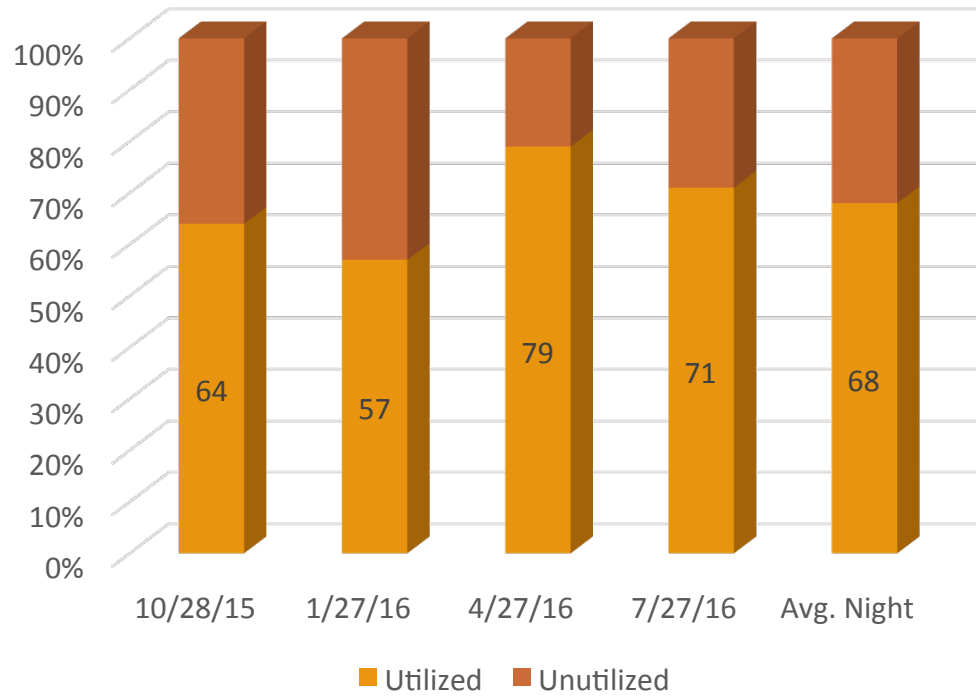


ES Individual Bed Utilization

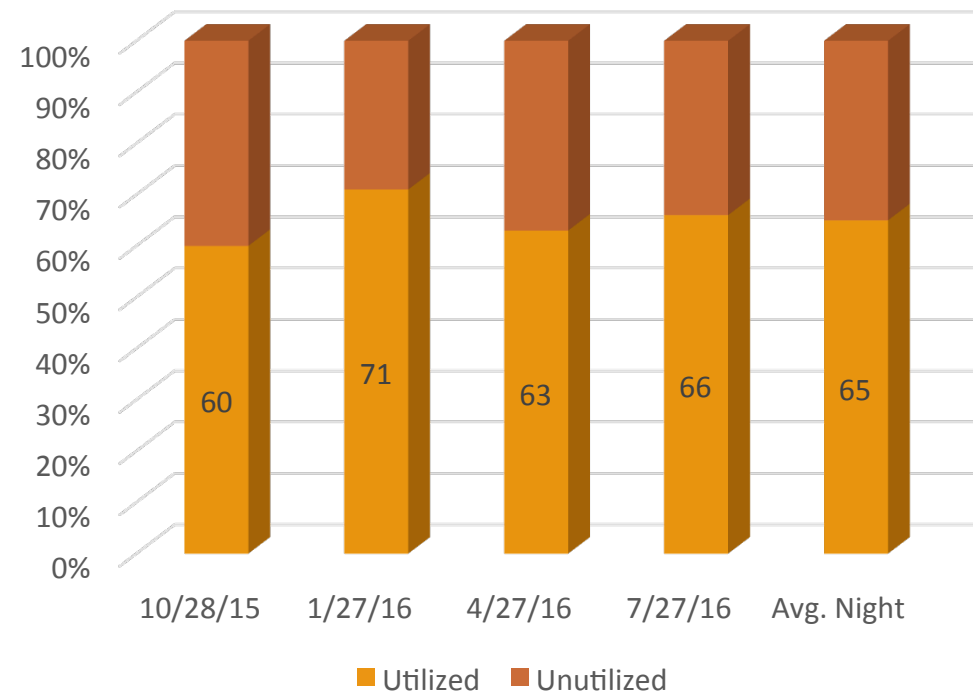


Transitional Housing Occupancy Rates

TH Family Unit Utilization

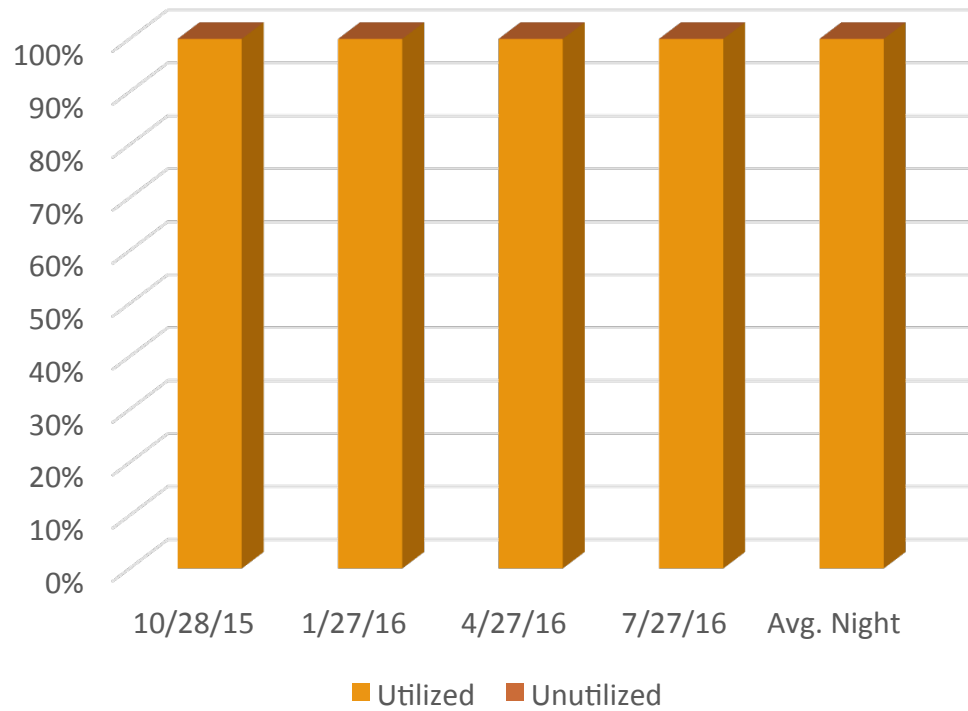


TH Individual Bed Utilization

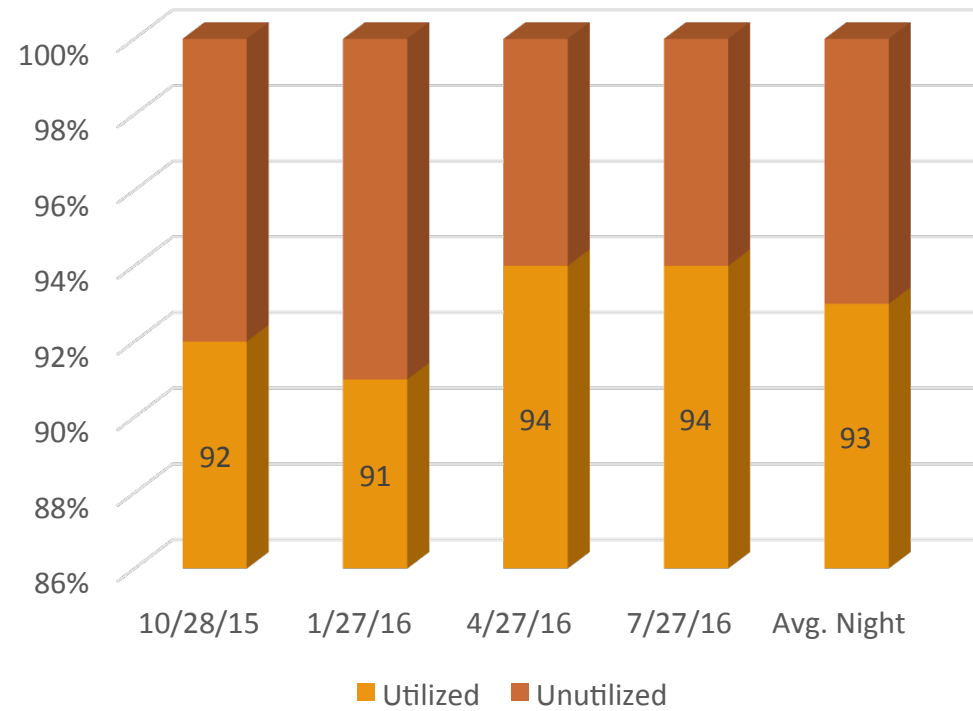


Permanent Supportive Housing Occupancy Rates

PSH Family Unit Utilization

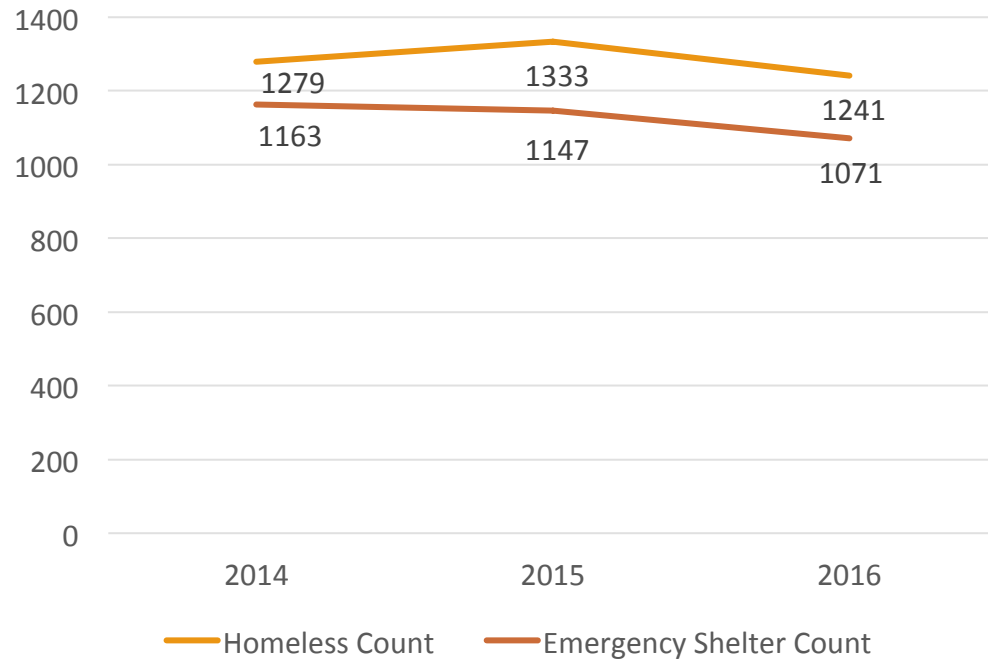


PSH Individual Bed Utilization

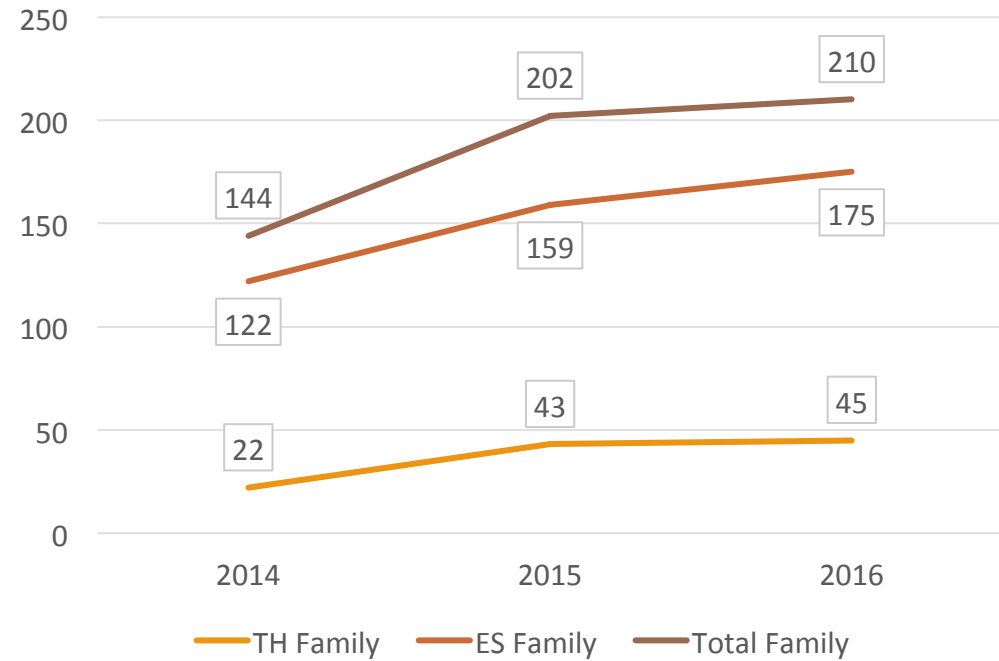

2014-2016 ANNUAL COUNTS

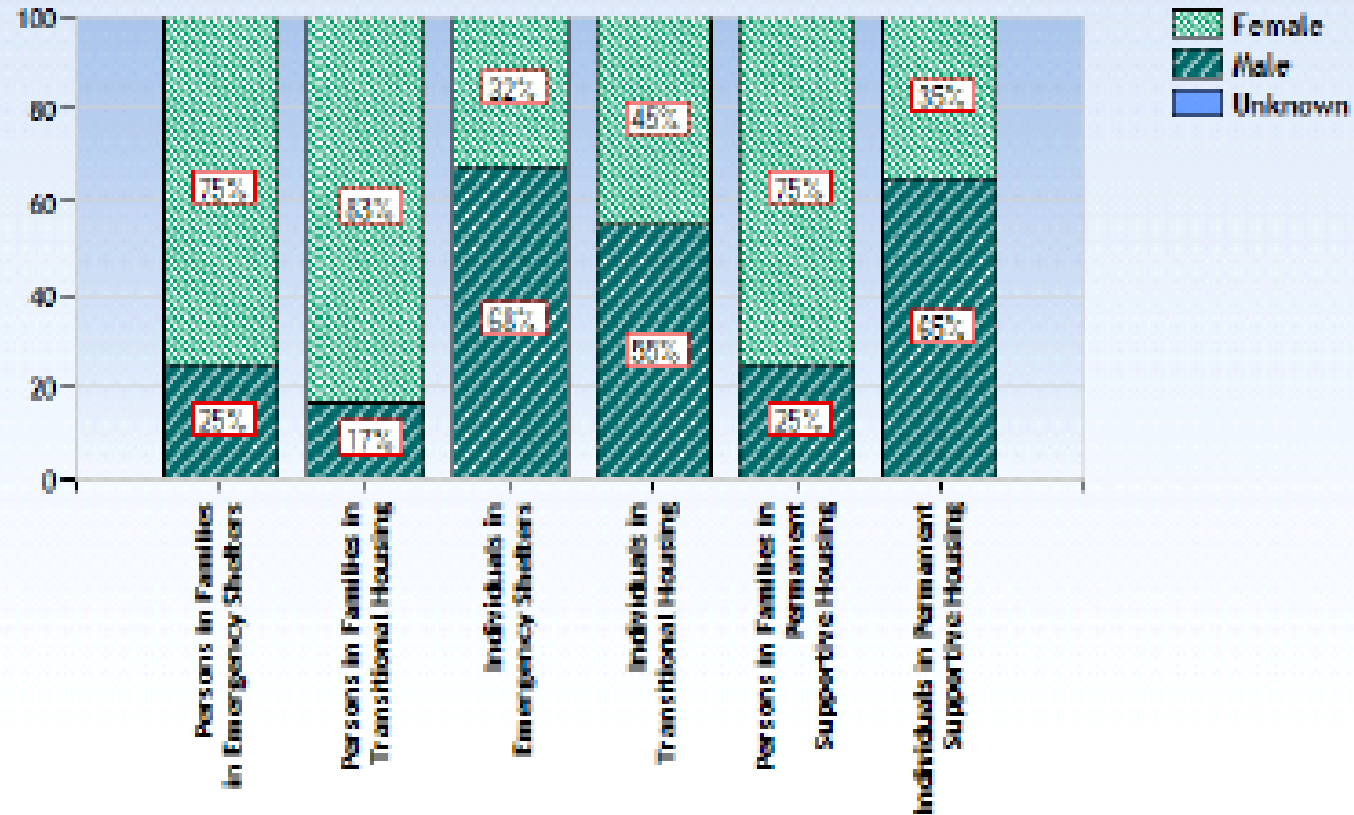


2014-2016 ANNUAL FAMILY COUNTS



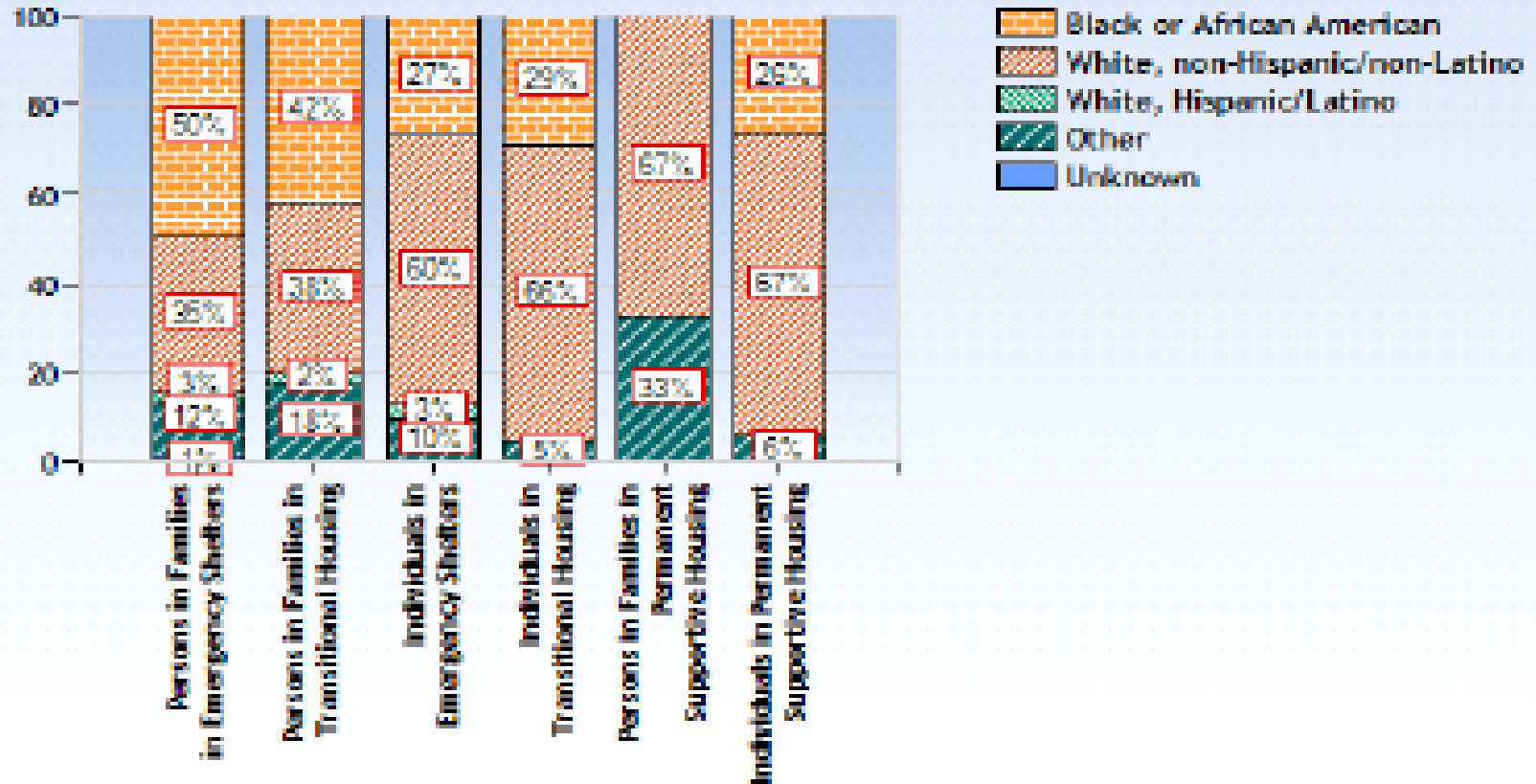

Exhibit 3.11 Demographic Characteristics: Age of Persons in Families in Emergency Shelter

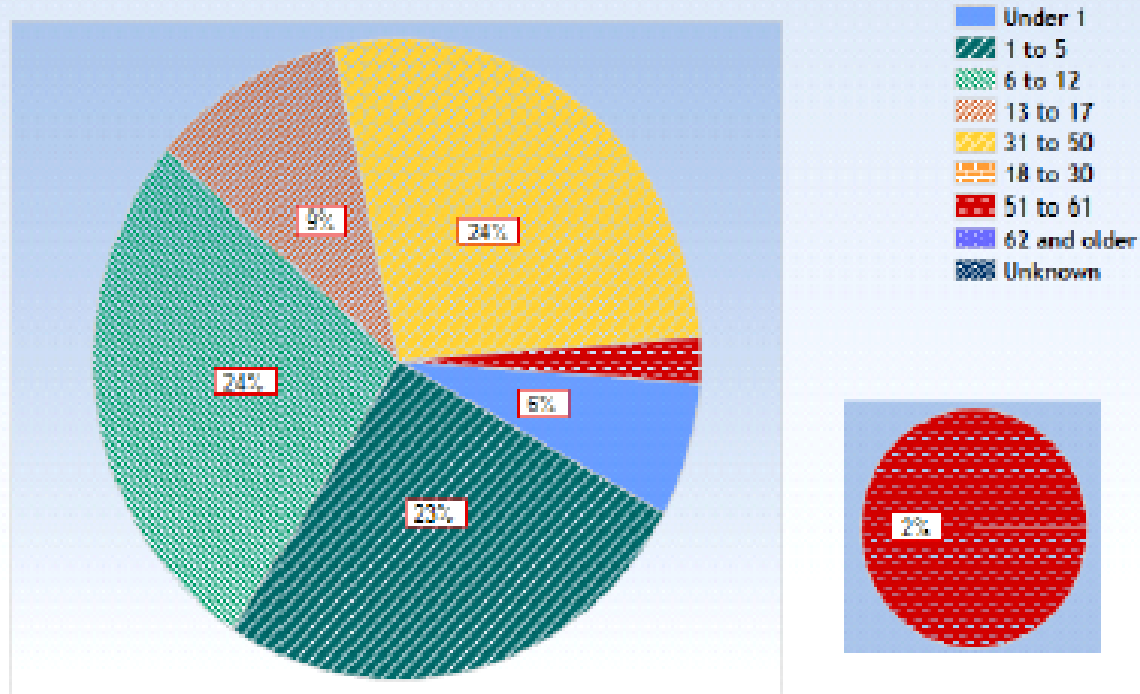


Exhibit 3.14 Demographic Characteristics: Age of Individuals in Emergency Shelter
