Summary of Removed and Delayed Projects in the Updated DRAFT 2024-2033 STIP (8/4/2022)

This document provides a snapshot summary of the projects that have funding or schedule impacts as a result of the recently released preliminary 2024-33 Draft Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP). The projects are broken into three categories:

1. The projects that have had ALL their funding removed. These projects are still listed in the draft STIP document but are listed as “NOT FUNDED.” This includes some projects that were previously “uncommitted” projects as well as some that were previously considered “committed.” These projects will need to recompete for funding in P7.0 in order to regain funding – projects in this category that were previously “committed” are no longer committed.
2. The projects that have had MOST of their funding removed but will remain funded for preliminary engineering/design work ONLY. These projects are listed in the draft STIP document as “FUNDED FOR PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING ONLY.” Some of these projects were previously considered “committed” projects but are now no longer committed. These projects will need to recompete for funding in P7.0 in order to regain funding.
3. The projects that remain “committed” (now termed “delivery projects”) but may have had changes to their schedule. These projects are listed in the draft STIP document as “SCHEDULED FOR DELIVERY.” Most of these projects for the CFRPO had no change to their current schedule.

At the November 2, 2022 CFRPO RTCC and November 10, 2022 RTAC meetings we will have additional discussion about the draft STIP and the possible methods for swapping projects in and out (if desired).

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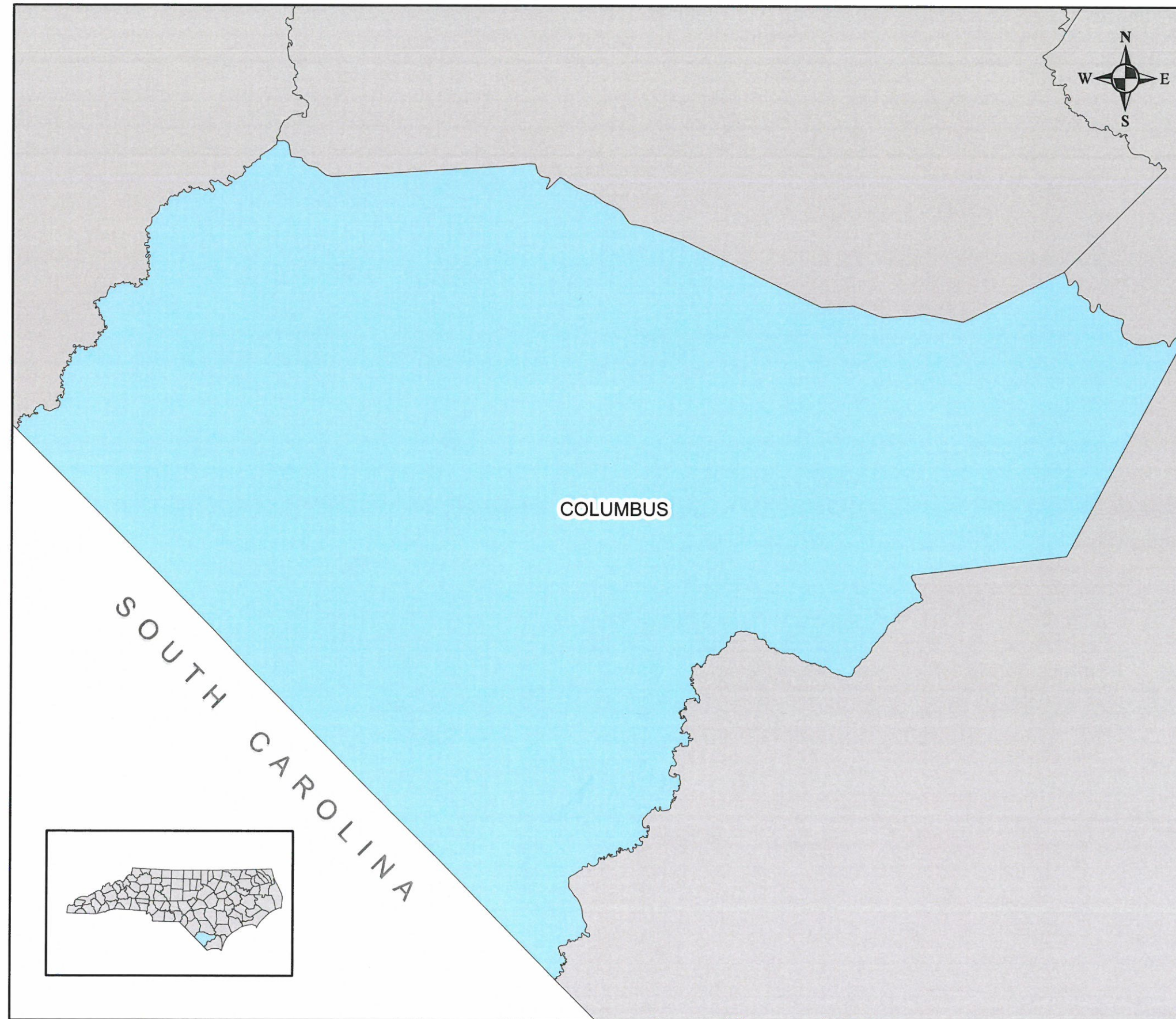

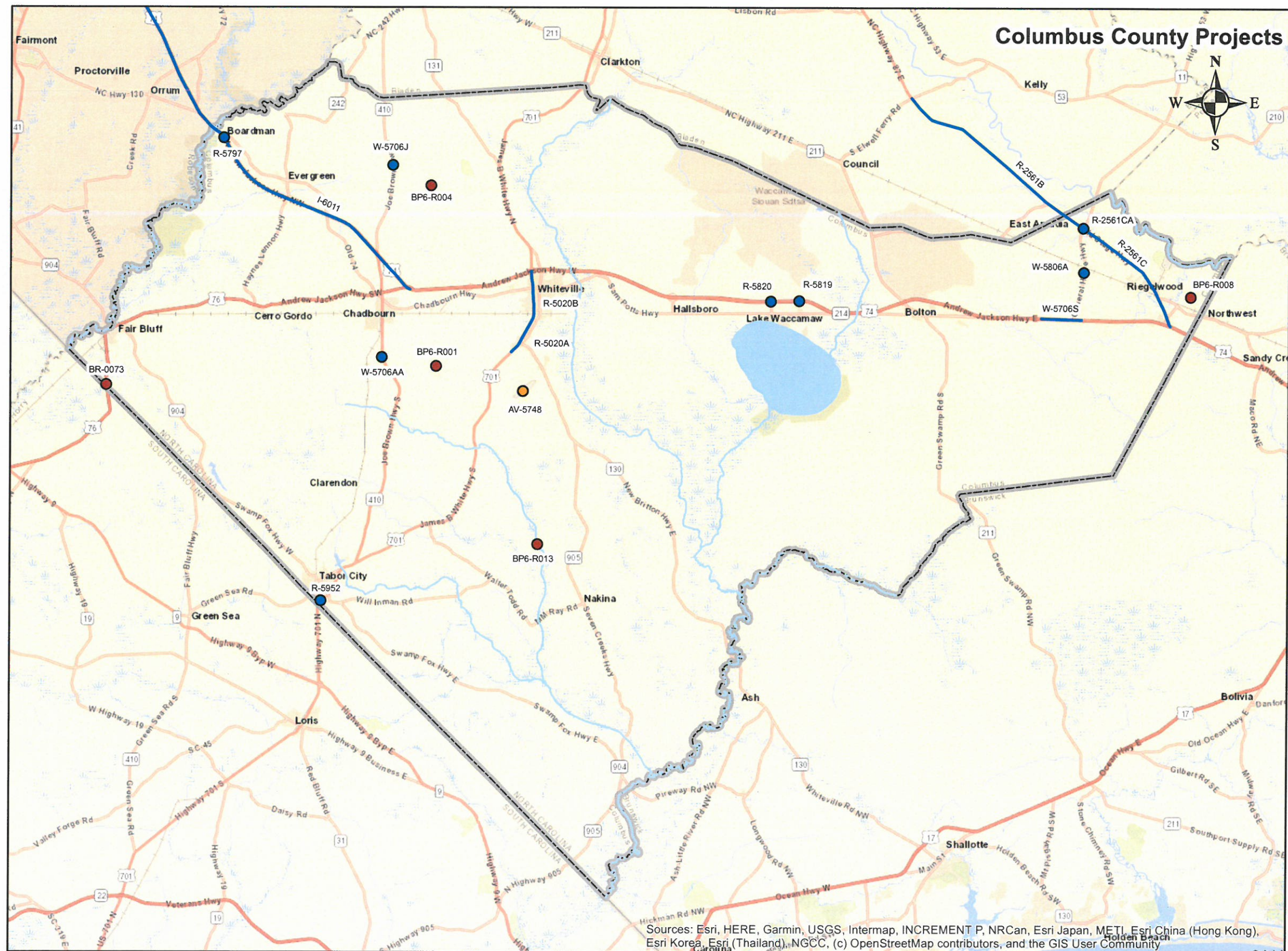

Brunswick County Model: The Brunswick County Model was completed in February of last year.

Brunswick County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP): The Brunswick County CTP went through Peer Review, Management Review and Steering Committee Review. The CTP was on pause for 8 month as the county reviewed and updated their scope and resumed in August of this year. The CTP engineers will reach out to the steering committee in the coming weeks to resume CTP efforts before public involvement. The engineers will start updating the data and working on the report to get ready for public involvement in the coming months. The CTP engineers are working with the RPO and county now to update some projects.

Columbus County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP): The engineer and planner went through several public involvement sessions in the month of August around difference locations in the county.

Wilmington Model: The 2050 Travel Demand Model (TDM) work started on 3/1/2022. The TDM is being developed for the next Wilmington MTP. Wilmington MPO has provided employment verification as well as all of the CO data that was requested from TPD. TPD is working on amending the TAZs, incorporating WMPO data feedback and updating the network and other information as part of the verification and data collection phase of the TDM.
