The Cape Fear Rural Planning Organization (CFRPO) is seeking approval for the amended FY 22-23 Planning Work Program. RPO staff deemed this necessary to align the PWP categories with the work priorities across the region. The changes have been reviewed by the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) on June 16, 2023. There is no change to the RPO's overall budget.

The changes that are being proposed:

II-1 CTP Development – decreased by \$6,500.00 since time spent on the adoption process for Brunswick and Columbus CTPs will not take place until early in FY23-24.

IV-1 Indirect Costs – decreased by \$6,000.00 to allocate funds to other PWP categories.

Funding was transferred to:

I-1 Data Collection and Assessment – increased by \$8,000.00 to account for gathering traffic counts, updating GIS records, and updating the RPO's Title VI Plan.

II-2 Prioritization – increased by \$1,000.00 to account for preparations for P7.0 submittals.

II-3 Program and Project Development – increased by \$600.00 to account for project development and express design meetings prior to P7.0 submittal window.

IV-3 Lodging, Meals, Incidentals – increased by \$1,000.00 to account for travel to statewide training meetings.

IV-4 Postage – increased by \$100.00 to account for mailing meeting notices and agenda packets.

IV-6 Travel – increased by \$1,800.00 to account for mileage across the region and to statewide training meetings.

JUNE TPD UPDATES CAPE FEAR RPO

JUNE 2023

Brunswick County Model: The Brunswick County Model was completed in February of last year.

Brunswick County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP): The Brunswick County CTP just completed public involvement sessions in May. The committee held three in-person open house drop-in sessions from the beginning of May through mid-May. The committee also created a virtual platform for feedback from May 1st through May 15th. The next steps are to compile all feedback/comments and take any major recommendations to the committee for final CTP updates. After the committee makes final changes, the CTP will be reviewed by TPD management, go to local adopting agencies for presentations, and then finally go back to the adopting agencies for adoptions.

Columbus County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP): Committee agreed upon updating the V/C maps, crash maps, and highway network from a base year of 2015 to 2021 and reprojecting to the same future year of 2045. Capacities will be updated from 2000 HCM to 2010 HCM, as well. Additional help from other TPD engineers is being provided to assist in the effort. The CTP Recommended Minimum Growth Rates Guidance was finalized on April 21st. The TFU, the traffic analysis tool, is in the process of being updated to include 2021 AADTs.

It is not anticipated that the current draft recommendations will require changes, but this won't be confirmed until the updated analysis is complete, and the results are shared with the steering committee. The final steering committee meeting was on May 4th, minor edits, draft adoption presentations, and to plan adoptions (pending updated analysis confirming no recommendation changes are needed). Adoptions are on hold until then.

Wilmington Model: The 2050 Travel Demand Model (TDM) work started on 3/1/2022. TPD just completed inventory checks and transit coding. Sent WMPO TDM network for verification, which they confirmed and provided more data. Now TPD is moving onto roadway networking coding.
