7. <u>Carbon Reduction Program Project Prioritization</u> – Staff explained that NCDOT has required RPOs to rank their submitted projects. Since there is no existing ranking methodology, RPO staff will explore possible ranking methodologies using criteria such as total carbon

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reduction, cost (carbon reduction to cost ratio), and equity. Staff will send findings to the RTCC for comments prior to presenting them to the RTAC.

8. P7.0 Carryover Projects – NCDOT is permitting MPOs, RPOs, and Divisions to select 2 new projects submittals from P6.0 to carryover to P7.0 without counting toward the maximum number of P7.0 project submittals. The 2 default projects (*based on their P6.0 Quantitative Scores*) are **H183735** (*NC 211 widening in Brunswick County*) and **H184205** (*US 701 Bypass in Columbus County*). It is possible that H183735 will be automatically reprioritized because of its status as a sibling project. RPO staff will seek further clarification from NCDOT on that matter. If H183735 will be automatically reprioritized, then staff recommends selecting **H184166** (*NC 87 widening in Brunswick County*) as the second Carryover project.

Travis Henley made a motion to recommend to the RTAC that H183735 and H184205 be selected as Carryover Projects unless H183735 is automatically carried over as a sibling project, in which case H184166 will be selected as Carryover. Gary Lanier seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken.

Staff noted that important considerations on this topic include staff resources at the MPOs compared to the RPOs, impacts on the Prioritization process, and voting rights of member governments.
- **14.** Cape Fear RPO 2023 Meeting Calendar Adjustments Staff proposed an addition to the RPO's 2023 Meeting Calendar to account for the P7.0 project submittal window. In past Prioritization cycles, the RPO has held RTCC/RTAC meetings in consecutive months during the project submittal window to allow additional time to consider project submissions. The P7.0 project submittal window is set for July-September of this year, and the RPO only has one meeting currently scheduled in that timeframe (September).
