FY 23-24 Planning Work Program

In June, NCDOT's Transportation Planning Division announced a **15% funding increase** for all RPOs effective FY23-24.

Local Match will now be determined by County Tiers. Since Cape Fear RPO contains a Tier 1 County, Local Match will be 5% and NCDOT will cover the remaining 15%.

Previous Allocation: Total = \$ 132,969 Local Match = \$ 26,594

New Allocation: Total = \$153,000 Local Match = \$7,650




