




WHAT

- Approx. 6 miles long combination of new and existing routes

WHY


- Reduce truck traffic in Burgaw's downtown
- Improve safety for all
- Reduce congestion along existing NC 53








A feasibility study presents recommended cross sections for improvements, general corridors of improvements, and estimated cost of construction and right-of-way.


This study attempts to **identify** any **potential** environmental, permitting, or other observed **issues** that deserve consideration in the planning and construction stages.















The Merger process is the part of project development where we work to select the Least Environmentally Damaging Practicable Alternative (LEDPA).


"One of the guiding principles for this study is that the heavy volume of tractor trailers **must be reduced** before most of the streetscape improvements proposed in the corridor can be implemented.


"The high volume of truck traffic can be limited by identifying an existing alternative truck route or a **bypass** of the community."
















The Burgaw Bypass: Why This Matters

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

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
