- 1. **Introduction and quorum** Having reached a quorum, Mr. Williams called the meeting to order at 9:06 AM. The attendees introduced themselves.
- 2. Ethics awareness and conflict of interest statement Mr. Williams read the statement to the RTAC. No conflicts were raised and no members recused themselves from any votes.
- 3. Changes or additions to the agenda Mr. Serkin requested amending the agenda to add an item to discuss to the NC Senate's proposed budget. *Mr. Mann made a motion to amend the agenda as presented, Mr. Helms seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 4. **Approval of the minutes** *Mr. Maxwell made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 5. **Public Comment** There was no comment from the public.
- 6. State Ethics Filings Mr. Serkin presented updates regarding the status of the State Ethics filings. Mr. Williams stated that he made contact with the State Ethics Commission to offer his opinion of the challenges of filing the online paper work and the need for a more user friendly process. Mr. Serkin informed members that two members have resigned as RTAC alternates and there are now two vacant positions.
- 7. **Cape Fear Regional Bicycle Plan Presentation** Mr. Serkin presented the background, purpose, and progress made on the Regional Bicycle Plan. Mr. Williams asked if the shared

bike trails would connect to mountain bike trails, and if they were primarily designed for recreation or transportation purposes. Mr. Serkin clarified that the routes in the Regional Bicycle Plan are primarily designed for transportation use. Mr. Serkin mentioned that future road projects identified by the Regional Bicycle Plan should be considered when NCDOT plans a project. *No action was necessary*.

- 8. **FY 16/17 Planning Work Program (PWP) Amendment** Mr. Serkin presented a revised PWP showing how the budget has been adjusted to satisfy particular budget categories. The rationale was presented behind these budget changes. *Mr. McCoy made a motion to approve the amendment, Mr. Helms seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 9. **FY 17-18 Planning Work Program (PWP)** Mr. Serkin presented the draft PWP for the upcoming fiscal year. Mr. Serkin explained the additional funds approved by NCDOT and how they will be allocated. Mr. Serkin mentioned that the additional funds were mostly allocated to Data Collection and Assessment to purchase traffic counters and start a traffic count collection program to supplement NCDOT's current traffic count program. *Mr. Helms made a motion to accept the revisions, Ms. Williams-Rowland seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 10. **FY 17/18 22/23 Five Year Planning Calendar** Mr. Serkin provided a summary of the tasks the CFRPO proposes to undertake over the next five years. *Mr. McCoy made a motion to accept the proposed five year planning calendar, Mr. Helms seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 11. **P5.0** Alternate Criteria Mr. Serkin explained the deadline for approval of alternate criteria is September 15th. Mr. Serkin summarized the difference between the alternate criteria and default criteria, and explained that CFRPO projects would have scored better with the default criteria than with the alternate criteria. Mr. Serkin recommended that 5% from Benefit-Cost be added to Congestion at the Regional tier, and 5% from Congestion and be added to Benefit-Cost at the Division tier. Mr. Serkin concluded that this will encourage more expensive projects at the Regional tier and more affordable projects at the Division tier. Mr. Williams recommended not to vote of the P5.0 resolution and strike the 3rd and 4th whereas clauses in the resolution supporting the construction of I-74 along the US-74 corridor in Brunswick and Columbus Counties. *Mr. Helms made a motion to accept the resolution, Mr. Mann seconded the motion. The motion carried. Mr. Helms made a motion carried.*
- 12. **P5.0 Project Modifications and Deletions** Mr. Serkin mentioned that the deadline for project modifications and deletion is July 30th. Mr. Serkin recommended that I-74 east of Bolton should be downgraded from Interstate standards to Freeway standards. Mr. Williams asked how the new commercial development at Maco Road and US 74/76 would affect the feasibility of upgrading the area from to Interstate standards. Mr. Serkin responded that planning will be necessary to ensure private properties will not be adversely affected. He concluded that receiving funding for the project is a priority, then as project development ensues, matters regarding private properties will be addressed. *Mr. Mann made a motion for the modifications and deletions, Mr. Helms seconded the motion. The motion carried.*

- 13. P5.0 New Project Solicitation Mr. Serkin explained that the deadline to approve the list of new project submittals for funding P5.0 is September 15th. Mr. Serkin stated that the CFRPO can submit 13-15 proposed projects to NCDOT for this upcoming year. Mr. Helms asked Mr. Serkin to send an email regarding new project solicitation. Mr. Serkin asked the members to submit a new project list to the CFRPO by July 21st so that it can be included in the RTCC/RTAC packets for August. *No action necessary*.
- 14. Cape Fear Regional Bicycle Plan Mr. Serkin requested a motion to recommend approval of the attached resolution adopting the plan. *Mr. McCoy made a motion for the Cape Fear Regional Bicycle Plan resolution approval, Mr. Maxwell seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 15. Resolutions to the NC Senate's Approved Budget Mr. Serkin explained the changes in the Senate's Budget for the term and mentioned that the Advanced Right-of-Way Acquisitions will benefit RPOs and MPOs. Mr. Serkin mentioned the proposal reduces the Tier I local match from 20% to 5%, and NCDOT will pay the 15% difference. Mr. Serkin explained that having a Tier I county in the CFRPO helps all other counties in the CFRPO. Mr. Williams recommended that the corridor development units, reducing local match, and the Advanced Right-Of-Way Acquisitions are the most important. Mr. Williams recommended to accept the resolutions but remove the last whereas clause in Section 34.17. The RTAC directed Mr. Serkin to send the proposed resolutions to NC Senators, Representatives, the Secretary of Transportation and the BOT. Mr. Maxwell made a motion to accept the proposed resolutions, if the last whereas clause of Section 34.17 is removed, Mr. McCoy seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- 16. **Reports/Updates** Mr. Serkin gave the CFRPO update. Mr. Pytcher gave the Division 3 update. Mr. Sturdivant gave the Division 6 update. Ms. Sarder gave the Transportation Planning Branch update.
- 17. **Adjournment** *There being no further discussion, Mr. McCoy made a motion to adjourn, Ms. Williams-Rowland seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.*

The NC Board of Transportation (BOT) approves the weighting formulas for the criteria by which transportation projects from all modes are prioritized for funding. The Strategic Transportation Investments (STI) law permits alternate weighting formulas (aka alternate criteria) at the Regional Impact and Division Needs tiers if the Division Engineer and all MPOs and RPOs in the division and/or region agree. In Prioritization 3.0, we agreed on an alternate criteria for Region B and Division 3 (which includes Brunswick & Pender). Region C and Division 6 (which includes Columbus) opted for the default criteria. In Prioritization 4.0, we agreed to use alternate criteria for Region B, Division 3, and Division 6 and the default criteria for Region C.

For P5.0, staff from MPOs, RPOs, and NCDOT divisions met to discuss alternate criteria. As successive rounds of Prioritization occur, the default criteria and the specific measures of each have been refined to better measure transportation needs and the benefits of proposed improvements. As a result, the staff from Region B and Division 3 felt that the default criteria were satisfactory and we agreed to use the default criteria at both tiers. The staff from Region C and Division 6 agreed to minor modifications to the default criteria.

The table below shows the alternate criteria we agreed on for Region C and Division 6 and the default criteria. Percentages in red are those that deviate from the default criteria. Measures in red indicate those that have changed for P5.0.

Projects can get a maximum of 50 quantitative points at the Division Needs tier 70 quantitative points at the Regional Impact tier. Therefore, the percentages add up to 50 or 70 respectively, not 100.

In order to use alternate criteria, they must be formally adopted by the RTAC. Likewise formal rejection of the alternate criteria is required to oppose those agreed to by all other parties.

After lengthy discussion at the RTCC, it was agreed that it was more likely that the Accessibility/Connectivity criterion would likely help Columbus County projects more relative to projects in the Triangle are than the Freight criterion, even though Columbus County projects, especially along US 74, score very well on the freight criterion. As a result, the *RTCC recommended* <u>rejecting</u> the Region C alternate in favor of the default criteria.

Upon evaluation of the alternate criteria for Division 6, the RTCC did not have the same concerns as with the Regional tier. As a result, the *RTCC recommended adopting the alternate criteria for Division 6*.

RESOLUTION 17-04

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING ALTERNATE P5.0 CRITERIA

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Planning Organization (RPO) was established to facilitate the coordination of transportation planning efforts between the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and local officials in the Cape Fear RPO planning boundary; and

WHEREAS, the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) is the duly established transportation planning policy board for the Cape Fear RPO; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Transportation Investments Law (STI) defines the prioritization process for transportation project funding in North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs), Rural Transportation Planning Organizations (RPOs) and the NCDOT Division Engineers are provided the opportunity to define alternate weighting formulas for the quantitative evaluation of Regional Impact and Division Needs transportation projects using the criteria adopted by the NC Board of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, Columbus County is located in Region C and Division 6, as defined by STI and the NCDOT; and

WHEREAS, the MPOs, RPOs, and NCDOT Division Engineers in Region C and Division 6 have unanimously proposed alternate weighting formulas for calculating quantitative scores for highway transportation projects in the Regional Impact and Division Needs tiers.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Cape Fear RPO Rural Transportation Advisory Committee hereby (1) opposes the proposed alternate criteria for scoring Regional Impact tier highway transportation projects in Region C in favor of the default criteria; and (2) agrees to the following proposed alternate criteria for scoring Division Needs highway transportation projects in Division 6:

DIVISION 6: Congestion 15%, Benefit-Cost 15%, Safety 15%, Freight 0%, Accessibility/Connectivity 5%.

A RESOLUTION REAFFIRMING SUPPORT OF A TOLL RATE INCREASE FOR THE SOUTHPORT-FORT FISHER FERRY

WHEREAS, the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) is the duly recognized transportation decision making body for the Cape Fear Rural Planning Organization (RPO), as authorized under NCGS 136-211; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the North Carolina General Assembly mandated that new capital improvements to the ferry system be funded through the Strategic Transportation Initiative (STI) or by revenue-raising initiatives such as tolling, advertising, and concessions; and

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Board of Transportation approved a tolling methodology but has taken no action to increase fares on the Southport-Fort Fisher Ferry; and

WHEREAS, the Southport-Fort Fisher Ferry route is currently tolled and all fares collected fund new ferry vessels and ferry improvements that directly benefit the Southport-Fort Fisher Ferry; and

WHEREAS, in 2014, the NCDOT proposed to retain the same fares for pedestrians, bicycles and motorcycles but increase the fares for vehicles less than 20 feet from \$5 to \$7, between 20 feet and 40 feet from \$10 to \$14 and greater than 40 feet from \$15 to \$28; and

WHEREAS, there is no proposed change in the price of a Commuter Pass, thereby protecting regular users from increased costs; and

WHEREAS, public comment at a February 18, 2014 meeting at Southport City Hall, as well as electronic mail received by RPO staff, was generally supportive of a rate increase; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2014 and May 20, 2016, the RTAC adopted a resolution in support of increasing the fares on the Southport-Fort Fisher Ferry; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Cape Fear Rural Planning Organization's Rural Transportation Advisory Committee hereby reaffirms its support for the proposed ferry toll increase for the Southport-Fort Fisher Ferry.

ADOPTED at a regular meeting of the Cape Fear Rural Planning Organization Transportation Advisory Committee on August 18, 2017.

Columbus County CTP – TPB is currently working on the problem statements for the Highway, Public Transportation, Rail, Bicycle, and Pedestrian recommendations. TPB received comments based on the maps and are working to make changes to the recommendation. TPB has received the rail alternatives from the Columbus County Rail Feasibility Study. The alternatives map is attached.

Wilmington Model Update – Wilmington MPO has requested that TPB update their model to a base year of 2015, previously the base year was 2010. The model is being updated so it can be accurately used in the next MTP. We are in the data collection process currently.

Wilmington CTP – With the model update, WMPO has also asked TPB to start on the Wilmington CTP update. We have yet to develop a schedule for this CTP and start – but will develop one within a month from now.

CTP 2.0 – The CTP 2.0 work is ongoing. The reports subcommittee has sent out the draft report for review to our internal and external partners. The reports subcommittee will look into each and every comment that was made and make edits as needed. The mapping subcommittee has completed their highway maps and are in the process of developing their bicycle, pedestrian, rail and public transportation maps.
