- 1. **Introduction and quorum** Having reached a quorum, Mr. Williams called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. The attendees introduced themselves.
- 2. **Invocation/Pledge of Allegiance** Mr. Dove led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. **Ethics awareness and conflict of interest statement** Mr. Williams read the statement to the RTAC. No conflicts of interest were raised and no members recused themselves from any votes.
- 4. **Additions or corrections to the agenda** Mr. Serkin recommended that a resolution of support be added to the agenda at the request of Brunswick County for a greenway project grant application. *Mr. Helms made a motion to approve the agenda with the addition, Ms. Williams-Rowland seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 5. **Approval of Minutes** *Mr. Forte made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, Mr. Caster seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 6. **Public Comment** There was no public comment.
- 7. **US 74 Corridor Master Plan Presentation** Mr. Serkin explained that NCDOT has put the project on hold to reevaluate the scope of the project to ensure a valuable product. The length of the delay is unclear but NCDOT will communicate the timeframe when it is determined. Mr. Williams suggested writing a letter to NCDOT to communicate the group's appreciation

- that NCDOT is reevaluating the project to improve the final product but to request minimizing the delay. The Board was in unanimous agreement.
- 8. Public Hearing: Prioritization 5.0 Final Regional Tier Point Assignments Mr. Serkin announced that the Final Regional Impact tier local input point assignments are due by July 27. Mr. Williams and Mr. Serkin summarized the prioritization process for the group. Mr. Serkin mentioned that NCDOT mischaracterized a rail project as being entirely located in the Fayetteville MPO but that 7% of the project is located in the Cape Fear RPO. The Fayetteville RPO offered to share 7 points with the CFRPO for the project. Mr. Serkin added that the GSATS MPO offered 65 points for the Carolina Bays Parkway project. Mr. Serkin recommended that the Cape Fear RPO accept points that are offered by FAMPO and GSATS. Mr. Zimmer requested that Mr. Serkin explained the overall point allocations for RPOs and MPOs. Ms. Marks went over Division 3's proposed point assignments at the regional tier. Mr. Serkin requested 6 points from Division 3 for the Delco Bypass which will be considered. Mr. Forte asked inquired the roundabout at Midway Road and Gilbert Rd. Mr. Forte identified a recent fatality at a curve near Antioch Church. Ms. Collette stated that all fatalities are investigated by NCDOT. Mr. Williams requested information regarding the investigation. Mr. Helms acknowledged a previously dangerous intersection that was improved by the installation of blinking lights that indicate the changing signal. Mr. Helms complimented NCDOT on this remedy. Mr. Williams opened the public hearing. There was no public comment at this time. Mr. Helms made a motion to approve the Regional Tier point assignments as proposed and to accept 7 points from the Fayetteville MPO for R171628, Mr. Dove seconded the motion. The motion carried.
- 9. **NC Ports BUILD Resolution** Mr. Serkin identified a minor language change to the resolution of support. Mr. Williams read the revised language. The resolution indicates the Cape Fear RPO supports the BUILD application. *Mr. Helms made a motion to approve the resolution, Ms. Williams-Rowland seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 10. **East Coast Greenway BUILD Resolution** Mr. Serkin explained that the East Coast Greenway Alliance is seeking support from RPOs to prepare a BUILD grant application to fund rural ECG corridor studies. *Mr. Helms made a motion to approve the resolution of support, Mr. Dove seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 11. **Brunswick County Greenway BUILD Resolution** Mr. Serkin explained that there is a resolution to support the grant application to study the construction of a greenway from NC 906 near NC 211 in Oak Island to NC 87 in Boiling Spring Lakes. The Pine Forest developer is providing a local match by constructing the portion within his project. Mr. Forte indicated environmental concerns with the Nature Conservancy. These concerns were reflected by other members. Marshall added that tree removal is a concern in the area as well. *Mr. Forte made a motion to support the grant application, Mr. Zimmer seconded the motion. The motion carried.*
- 12. **Reports/Updates** Mr. Serkin provided an update for the Prioritization 5.0, Columbus County CTP, and Brunswick County CTP. Mr. Serkin also noted the recent NCBOT approval of the toll rate increase for the Southport-FT. Fisher Ferry, the Build NC act and the

CSX Intermodal Facility. Mr. Zimmer asked Mr. Serkin to clarify the CSX facility change. Mr. Serkin said that the facility is changing to a standard intermodal terminal. Mr. Kimes provided a Division 3 update and highlighted a large project to mitigate flooding on NC 133 as well as the Surf City bridge project. Mr. Sturdivant provided an update for Division 6 and highlighted that the US 74 Hallsboro Rd project is underway. Mr. Sturdivant indicated that Division 6 will assign 91 points to the Delco Bypass project. Ms. Sarder gave the Transportation Planning Division update as well as timeline for the Columbus County CTP and the Brunswick County CTP. Ms. Sarder also indicated that there has been a request for a CTP for Pender County. Mr. Zimmer did not provide a NCBOT update.

- 13. **Open Discussion:** There was no further discussion at this time.
- 14. **Adjournment** There being no further discussion, Mr. Caster made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Helms seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at 10:05 AM.



Carolina Bays Parkway Extension

Project Overview and Purpose

The N.C. Department of Transportation, along with the S.C. Department of Transportation, is planning to build a multi-lane expressway that extends Carolina Bays Parkway (S.C. 31) from S.C. 9 in Horry County, S.C., across the North Carolina state line to U.S. 17 in Brunswick County.

The extension would provide a more direct and efficient movement of traffic seeking to bypass congestion within the areas of Calabash in North Carolina as well as Little River and the Grand Strand areas in South Carolina. It would also improve traffic flow and sfety at the intersection of S.C. 9 and S.C. 57 and provide a more direct route for coastal truck traffic moving through North Carolina.

Project Highlights

A team of engineering firms, led by CALYX Engineers and Consultants, is under contract to conduct project development and environmental studies, which are being led by NCDOT and SCDOT in cooperation with local, state and federal agencies in both states.

Project development and environmental studies are underway to evaluate potential routes for the roadway from an engineering and environmental standpoint and to select a preferred route.

Currently only programmed for planning and environmental study. No schedule has been established for right-of-way acquisition or construction, which is not currently funded in North Carolina.





New Business:

Columbus County CTP – CTP is in internal review currently while continuing to make additional edits.

Brunswick County Model - Model FY is now anticipated to be completed end of November.

Wilmington Model Update – Future Year Model completed end of August. Model closeout with documentation is to be completed by end of September.

Pender County CTP – Anticipated to start in fall of this year, currently TPD is working out the new schedule to align with CTP 2.0.

Statewide Plan: WSP has been issued a notice to proceed as of late August, so the NC 2050 Statewide Transportation Plan is now under way. The Statewide Plan is a policy based plan that will serve as a long-term investment blueprint for the state of North Carolina. As stakeholders, MPO/RPOs will be engaged throughout the process.

Corridor Studies: After establishing the Strategic Transportation Corridor (STC) network in 2015, the next step in implementation is the development of STC master plans, which are intended to establish a vision for each of the end-to-end corridors. Work began in early 2018 on the first two STC master plans, as follows:

- Bundle #1 has been assigned to Kimley-Horn and includes Corridor P (Future I-42/US 70E/ NCRR from I-440 in Wake County to Port at Morehead City), Corridor S (I-795/US 117 from I-95 in Wilson County to I-40 in Sampson County), and Corridor X (US 258/NC 11/US 13 from US 17 in Onslow County to US 64E in Edgecombe County)
- Bundle #2 has been assigned to Atkins, and includes Corridor U (US 74W/US 74E/I 74 from I-26 in Polk County to US 117 in Wilmington) and Corridor D (US 321/CSX from South Carolina state line to Tennessee state line).

TPD has recently made the decision to temporarily pause the development of the STC Master Plans in order to reevaluate the scope and deliverables to make it a more useful and effective end product. A work group of internal and external partners to help reexamine this effort has met once in August and will meet again in September.

CTP 2.0: TPD leadership is reviewing elements for CTP 2.0 and coordinating with the CTP 2.0 steering committee as we prepare for implementation of improved maps, classifications, analysis, plan documentation, and changes to the process for developing CTPs in NC. (A CTP Steering Committee meeting was held June 18, 2018.) Improving the CTPs for NCDOT and local partners has proven to be a complex process with many benefits and "ripple effects" as we move future proposals into project implementation.

Old Business:

Wilmington CTP – With the model update, WMPO has also asked TPD to start on the Wilmington CTP update. We have yet to develop a schedule for this CTP and start – but once the Wilmington Model is fully completed, TPD will develop a schedule.

RPO Program Reviews: FHWA submitted their findings and recommendations for improvement to NCDOT. TPD has developed an action plan to address the recommendations. FHWA, NCDOT and the RPO Administrative Documents Committee with collaborate on the implementation of resulting changes.

CMAQ: Applications for funding in FFY 2019 were due by March 15, 2018.

Traffic Forecast: The Traffic Forecast shapefile is under development (ArcGIS Online).

HERE Data: HERE Data is available for use for NCDOT business purposes, subsequently being available for RPO use. Data available for travel times and speed measures across the state. Program available at: https://pda.ritis.org/suite

FHWA News: Functional Classification - FHWA has an interactive map that shows the Federal highway system, freight network, fatal crashes, MPO information, and demographic maps at the county level.

Build NC: Governor Roy Cooper on Wednesday June 20, 2018 - signed into law the Build NC Bond Act of 2018, a new financing tool sought by his administration to help expedite critical highway projects. Build NC is a financing tool similar to Garvee bonds and is an important way to move critical projects forward. It is important to note that it is not new revenue, but borrowing authority to implement projects sooner. The focus is for projects in the regional and Division tiers.
