- **6.** Gullah Geechee Cultural Heritage Corridor Multi-Use Greenway/Blueway Trail Brayton Willis with the Brunswick County Branch of the NAACP gave a presentation on the Gullah Geechee Cultural Heritage Corridor Multi-Use Greenway/Blueway Trail. The presentation covered historical context, existing features, current efforts, and future plans. They are requesting support from the RPO in their planning efforts for the trail.
