






The Cape Fear Area Agency on Aging (AAA) was established through the Older Americans Act to facilitate and support programs addressing the needs of older adults and their caregivers in Region O. AAAs are overseen by the federal Administration for Community Living and the North Carolina Division of Aging and Adult Services and are charged with providing a comprehensive, community directed service delivery model that meets local needs and preferences. As part of a national network, the Cape Fear Area Agency on Aging works with the lead agency for aging services in each county providing advocacy, planning, program/resource development, information brokerage and funds administration quality assurance. The information presented here contains some program highlights from Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

## HOME AND COMMUNITY CARE BLOCK GRANT (HCCBG)

Federal, state, and local funds support the following services delivered within the region: congregate and homedelivered meals; transportation; in-home aide services; legal assistance; adult day care/day health; senior center operations; and information/case assistance/options counseling.

## CAPE FEAR HOMELESS CONTINUUM OF CARE

The Cape Fear Homeless Continuum of Care (CFHCoC) is the HUD-approved Homeless Continuum of Care (CoC) for the City of Wilmington, Brunswick, New Hanover, and Pender Counties. The CFHCoC is an alliance of service providers, local government agencies, health-care agencies and other community stakeholders whose goal is to reduce and ultimately eliminate homelessness in our region. The Continuum of Care's responsibilities include coordination of services and housing resources for those experiencing homelessness as well as ensuring recipients comply with grant funding requirements and operate in a fiscally responsible manner.

The CFCOG serves as the administrative home for the CoC, providing staff and fiscal sponsorship to the alliance. On an annual basis, staff organize and collaborate on State and Federal grant competitions with the community bringing in approximately \$835,000 in funding to provide emergency services and homeless housing programs to support individuals and families who are experiencing homelessness.

The CoC staff works with CFHCoC members and the CoC Board to create best practices, improve data collection, improve data quality, broaden relationships, and strategically address needs within the community.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICES

The Local Government Services (LGS) department provides member governments with a wide variety in four broad categories: Management, Planning, Transportation, and Data & Mapping. The department provides knowledge, experience, and staffing to supplement and extend member government capacity to meet the needs of our communities.

### MANAGEMENT SERVICES

This section Includes personnel and pay studies, codes of ordinances, human resources and financial consulting, infrastructure asset management planning, grant writing and administration, and training and retreats for elected and appointed boards.

## PLANNING SERVICES

Staff engage in long-range planning activities such as comprehensive plans, land use plans, hazard mitigation plans, park and recreation master plans, small area plans, and special studies; and current planning activities such as development review, development regulations, and zoning administration.

## TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

This aspect entails staffing and administration of the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Planning Organization (RPO), which provides transportation planning and advocacy for our non-metropolitan areas, as well as special transportation studies like corridor plans, bicycle and pedestrian plans, and parking and sidewalk inventories.

### MAPPING, DESIGN, AND DATA SERVICES

The department assists with GIS mapping and spatial data analysis; GPS data collection and infrastructure mapping; 2- and 3-dimensional conceptual designs; and data access and management consulting. We develop and maintain several spatial databases of local facilities like sidewalks and parks, as well as serving as the regional State Data Center Affiliate.



# Administration and Finance

The administration and finance staff provide support for other CFCOG departments in the areas of general office services, facility management, budget and financial management, human resources, event and meeting support, and general oversight and management. ## FY 2021-22 HIGHLIGHTS
